The term "voluntary" is used to denote a piece of music or improvisation for instrument, played before, during, or at the end of a church service.

The Season after Epiphany, also called **Ordinary Time**, means that which is standard, normative, usual, or typical. Since Ordinary Time is not a season, this period allows Sunday to be preeminent. Twice each year Ordinary Time is heightened by the extra-ordinary time of the Christmas and Easter cycles. They are extra-ordinary in that they intensify the foundational doctrines of incarnation and resurrection. This period ends on **Transfiguration of the Lord**, the Sunday before **Ash Wednesday**, the beginning of **Lent**. The color for Ordinary Time is GREEN, signifying spiritual growth (except on Communion Sundays when the color is white).

May God richly bless you as you travel and be refreshed!



A six-week Pastor's Class continues on **Mondays at 1:00 p.m.** in **Knox Hall** to study together N.T. Wright's popular book, *Surprised by Hope: Rethinking Heaven, the Resurrection, and the Mission of the Church*. The class will last one hour. Wright's premise is that Christians normally think of the future in terms of "heaven," but the promised reality is far greater: a new heaven and a new earth, a whole new creation. He believes once we grasp this biblical vision of God's future, it will transform our understanding of life in the present. Each session begins with a video segment given by Wright himself, followed by a group discussion. The six sessions include: "Hope for the World," "The Hope of the Resurrection," "The Hope of Heaven," "**The Hope of Jesus' Second Coming**," "The Hope of Salvation," and "The Hope of the Church." *Look forward to seeing you in the class!*

WHAT HAPPENED ON THIS DAY IN CHRISTIAN HISTORY

† **Rene Descartes** (b. 1596) died on this day in 1650. A French scientist and philosopher, he, beginning with radical skepticism, attempted to prove through deductive reasoning the existence of the world and God. † February 1, 1750, marks the marriage of **John Newton** and **Mary Catlett**. They lived together until her death forty years later, and their love story is one of the tenderest in Christian history. John Newton, a British pastor, was the author of *“Amazing Grace.”* † Today is the birthday of **Thomas Campbell** (1763), founder of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). † **Baylor University** was founded on this day in 1845, in Independence, Texas, under Baptist sponsorship. First known as the Texas Baptist Educational Society, it was moved to Waco in 1866 where it consolidated with Waco University and adopted the present name of Baylor. † **Julia Ward Howe** published her famous *“Battle Hymn of the Republic”* on February 1, 1862, in *The Atlantic Monthly*. † American missionaries **Charles** and **Lettie Cowman** set sail for Japan, as missionaries on this day in 1901. During the course of their ministry, they founded the Oriental Missionary Society which supported mission works in Japan, Korea, Formosa, and China. Mrs. Cowman later became famous for her devotional book, *Streams in the Desert*. † February 1, 1909, is the birthday of **George Beverly Shea**, long-time crusade partner of **Billy Graham** and America’s beloved gospel singer. † The **Lutheran Free Church** (an American denomination with Norwegian roots) merged with the **American Lutheran Church** on this day in 1963. The resulting group had a total membership of nearly 2.5 million. A conservative minority of Lutheran Free churches did not choose to merge and formed the Association of Free Lutheran Congregations.
