The term "voluntary" is used to denote a piece of music or improvisation for instrument, played before, during, or at the end of a church service.

The Season after Pentecost, also called Ordinary Time, begins the day after Pentecost and ends the day before the First Sunday of Advent. It may include twenty-three to twenty-eight Sundays, depending on the date of Easter, but the first Sunday is always Trinity Sunday, and the last Sunday is always the Sunday of the Reign of Christ or Christ the King. Although the scripture lessons in the lectionary for this half of the year go in a semi-continuous cycle through books of the Bible rather than follow a theme, the gospel lessons cover Jesus' teaching ministry and the church's mission in the world. The liturgical color for this season is GREEN, signifying growth in Christ, except on Communion Sundays when it is white.

WHAT HAPPENED ON THIS DAY IN CHRISTIAN HISTORY

P On October 26, 431, the Council of Ephesus drew to a close. This was the third General Church Council, summoned in the hope of settling the Nestorian controversy. October 26, 1466, marks the birth of **Desiderius Erasmus** in Rotterdam, Holland. After studying and teaching in the leading universities of Europe, he increasingly believed the church stood in need of reform. His Greek New Testament (1516) became one of the classics of Christian history and showed scholars (particularly a monk named Martin Luther) what the church should really be and teach. † On October 26, 1529, Thomas More was named Lord Chancellor under King Henry VIII. More was a deeply religious man who opposed Protestants and refused to recognize King Henry as head of the Church of England. Henry imprisoned him in the Tower of London and later had him beheaded. October 26, 1751, marks the death of Puritan pastor, author, and hymnwriter, **Phillip Doddridge**, a prolific writer whose best-known work was The Rise and Progress of Religion in the Soul. He died at age 58, at the height of his ministry, from tuberculosis. Among his hymns is "O Happy Day." + October 26, 1813, is the birthday of Henry T. Smart, British organist who wrote the music for "Lead On, O King Eternal" and "Angels from the Realms of Glory." + The International Red Cross was organized in Geneva on this day in 1863. * Mother Teresa founded her first Mission of Charity in Calcutta, India, on this day in 1950.
